

## Rules for survival - (of restorations and teeth)

**Prof Trevor Burke** has worked in academia and general dental practice for over forty years. His academic experience includes work at the Unit of Restorative Dentistry at the University of Manchester, Professor of Primary Dental Care at the University of Birmingham and Honorary Consultant in Restorative Dentistry since 2000. Trevor is (co)author of 330 papers in peer-reviewed journals and three books. He has been awarded over 80 research grants. His main research interests include properties and applications of tooth-colored restorative materials, and the translation of in vitro research on dental materials into the clinical situation. In this regard, he co-ordinates the work of the PREP (Product Research and Evaluation by Practitioners) Panel, established in 1993, a group of dentists who carry out research in their practices.

## Innovations within boundaries - Integrating CAD/CAM into Restorative Dentistry

**Dr Rupert Austin** is a Clinical Lecturer and Hon. Consultant in Prosthodontics at King's College London Dental Institute where he is also Service Lead for Digital Dentistry. He has implemented modern digital dentistry into undergraduate and postgraduate teaching at King's College London as well as working part time in multi-Specialist Private Practice. He actively researches projects into tooth wear and digital dentistry and regularly publishes research in peer-reviewed scientific journals.

**Dr Sophie Watkins BSRD President Elect** is a Consultant in Restorative Dentistry at Guy's Dental Hospital, where she has worked since 2004. She teaches on the KCL Prosthodontics MCLinDent programme at Guys as well as being training lead for restorative StR and DCT training at Guy's. **Dr Ken Hemmings** was president of the British Society for Restorative Dentistry 2014-15. Ken has had a long a distinguished career in dentistry which began when he graduated with honours in Dental Surgery from Bristol University in 1982. Junior hospitals posts followed at Bristol, Birmingham and Torquay before gaining a Registrar in Oral Surgery position at the Royal London Hospital. He gained his London fellowship in 1986 before entering the specialty of Restorative Dentistry. A two year MSc programme in Conservative Dentistry at the Eastman Dental Hospital was followed by registrar and then Senior Registrar training at the Eastman in 1993. He was appointed as Consultant in the departments of Conservative Dentistry and Periodontology in August 1995. He is recognised by the GDC as a specialist in Restorative Dentistry, Prosthodontics, Periodontology and Endodontics. He has examined for the Royal Colleges of England and Edinburgh, National University of Singapore and Peninsula University. He is currently on the editorial board for Dental Update. He has over 50 publications and now shares his time between hospital and private practice.
