Speakers



Professor Winston WL Chee D.D.S.

Ralph & Jean Bleak Professor of Restorative Dentistry; Director, Implant Dentistry, University of Southern Carolina

Dr Winston Chee is the Ralph W. and Jean L. Bleak Professor of Restorative Dentistry at the School of Dentistry, University of Southern California. He is a Diplomate of the American Board of Prosthodontics and has been a full time faculty member of the University of Southern California School of Dentistry since 1986. He has developed and taught courses at the pre and post doctoral levels, published over 50 articles on dental materials and implants in peer reviewed journals and lectured world wide on the subject of implant dentistry.

He is on the editorial board of the Compendium of continuing education in Dentistry and a Consultant on Implant Dentistry to the Council of Dental Materials Equipment and Devices, American Dental Association. At present he is the Director Implant Dentistry. He also maintains a Private Practice Limited to Prosthodontics in Pasadena, California. He is a Fellow of the American College of Prosthodontists, Fellow of the American College of Dentists, Member of the American Academy of Restorative Dentistry, CAIC study club, Academy of Osseointegration.



Professor William P Saunders

Professor of Endodontology Dean, Dundee Dental School, University of Dundee

Bill Saunders graduated in 1970 and spent five years in the Royal Air Force before entering general dental practice as a Principal for six years. He then embarked upon an academic career with higher training in Restorative Dentistry. He was appointed the first Professor of Endodontology in the UK in 1993, first at the University of Glasgow then, in 2000, at the University of Dundee. Appointed Dean of Dentistry and Head of Department in the same year. Research interests include broad aspects of Endodontology and applied Dental Materials. Clinical interests include surgical and non-surgical root canal retreatment and restoration of the root filled tooth. He has been President of the British Endodontic Society and is currently Chairman of the Education Committee of the European Society of Endodontology. He was Editor of the International Journal for seven years from 1991-1998 and is now a Consultant Editor. He sits on the Council of the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh Dental Faculty. He was recently appointed President-elect of the European Society of Endodontology and will host the biennial meeting in Edinburgh in 2009.



Ailbhe McDonald

Consultant in Restorative Dentistry Honorary Clinical Senior Lecturer UCL Eastman Dental Institute

Ailbhe McDonald graduated from Trinity College, Dublin in 1981. She completed an MSc in Conservative Dentistry at the Eastman Dental Institute in 1986, obtained her Fellowship of the Edinburgh Royal College in 1989 before completing her PhD at Trinity College, Dublin in 1997. She is currently Consultant in Restorative Dentistry and Hon. Clinical Senior Lecturer at the Eastman Dental Hospital, London. She has published widely and is a well known and respected postgraduate teacher in Fixed Prosthodontics. Her research interests lie in dental ceramics and dental implants, the restoration of endodontically treated and extensively damaged teeth and in the effects of lasers on the dental hard tissues.



Paul Stone

Associate Specialist in Oral Surgery Perth Royal Infirmary, Scotland Honorary Teaching Fellow, Edinburgh Postgraduate Dental Institute Past President, Association of Dental Implantology

Paul Stone graduated with honours from Liverpool University Dental School and is a registered Specialist in both Oral Surgery and Surgical Dentistry. He is the past President of the Association of Dental Implantology (ADI), a member of the GDC appointed group looking at Training Standards in Implant Dentistry, and the first UK Board member of the European Association for Osseointegration (EAO). He is based at the Tayside Maxillofacial unit where he also has a private practice. He is a member of lecturing staff at both Edinburgh Post-graduate Dental Institute and Dundee University Dental School, and has lectured in the UK and overseas for many years. He is an examiner for the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh and a Fellow of the International Team for Implantology (ITI).
