Matthew Garrett graduated in Bristol before commencing General Professional Training in Edinburgh. He worked in general practice and at the Charles Clifford Dental Hospital before completing his Restorative higher specialist training at Bristol Dental Hospital. He completed an MSc involving a prospective study on the longevity of resin-retained bridgework provided at Bristol Dental Hospital. Matthew obtained the intercollegiate speciality fellowship examination in Restorative Dentistry from the Royal College of Surgeons of England in 2009.

He is currently a Consultant in Restorative Dentistry and Deputy Director of Education at the Eastman Dental Hospital and is also an elected Board Member of the Faculty of Dental Surgery of the Royal College of Surgeons of England. Matthew's clinical interests are centred around fixed tooth replacement including the placement and restoration of dental implants. He is also currently an examiner for MRD and Deputy Lead for the OSCE component of the MJDF Examination.



Simon Ellis qualified from Birmingham University in 1991 and after a series of junior hospital positions and general practice undertook an MSc at Manchester University and completed the dental fellowship in 1997. He undertook a five year specialist training position at Sheffield Dental Hospital and Leciester General Hospital with secondments to Oslo cleft centre, Gothenburg implant clinic and the Morrison maxillofacial unit. Accrediting as a consultant in 2003 after completing the specialist fellowship at Edinburgh RCS he was a consultant at Torbay Hospital for six years from 2003 before joining the head and neck oncology multidisciplinary team at Poole Hospital in 2009. Alongside his hospital positions he works in specialist practice and established a restorative and implant dentistry referral service in Dorchester in 2004 and relocated this service to the South Coast Dental Specialist centre built in Dorchester in 2013.
