Dear Colleagues,


It is my privilege to welcome you all back to the annual Autumn Scientific Meeting for 2022.

Speakers



Ali Chohar

A Multidimensional Perspective On Communication And Neurolinguistics

Ali is GDP who has completed training in Coaching, NLP, Hypnotherapy and Education. He is currently appointed as a Clinical Advisor to NHS England and the GDC. He serves a statutory role on the Performance Advisory Group of NHS England as a discipline specific member.

Ali lectures for Health Education England for CPD and FD courses and is an Educational Supervisor for Dental Foundation Training. He also lectures for various private academies and has presented internationally on numerous occasions.



Graeme Bryce

Immediate dental implant rehabilitation within the UK Armed Forces

Graeme Bryce joined the Royal Navy Dental Service in 1999 on a Naval Cadetship whilst studying for a BDS at Glasgow University. In 2001 he completed All Arms Commando Course and subsequently served with 45 Cdo and 40 Cdo Royal Marine Units, deploying on operations in Northern Ireland, Iraq and afloat. In 2011 he was awarded membership to the Endodontic Specialist list and also commenced specialist training in Restorative Dentistry, as a Registrar at the Eastman Dental Hospital. In 2017, he was appointed as a Consultant in Restorative Dentistry, providing complex dental rehabilitation for military patients, at the Defence Centre for Rehabilitative Dentistry. Subsequently, he has led the transformation of military restorative care pathways, via the development and integration of a military Managed Clinical Network. Innovation has been crucial to the success of this MCN, with the adoption of digital platforms that improved patient access to care and the procurement of intra-oral scanning equipment, to fully digitize prosthetic treatment pathways. He has lectured extensively and also developed an online teaching hub to meet the educational needs of GDPs and clinicians working within the MCN. Graeme is currently serving his second 3-year term as the Defence Specialist Advisor in Restorative Dentistry, supplementing this position with the multiple presentations at National dental meetings and publication of multiple research papers and articles within peer-reviewed journals.



Martin Kelleher

Fallacies, Fashions And Fantasies In Restorative Dentistry

Martin is a Consultant in Restorative Dentistry at King's College London Dental Institute and is on the GDC specialist lists for Restorative Dentistry and Prosthodontics. He is a past President of the British Society for Restorative Dentistry and a past President of Southern Counties Branch of the British Dental Association. He has spoken at multiple BSRD meetings, starting in 1978.

Martin was on the board of Dental Protection for 10 years and chaired their Advisory Committee on Dental Claims for many years. He has lectured nationally and internationally on topics as varied as strategic thinking about managing compromised dentitions, fixed and removable prosthodontic techniques, facts and fallacies about occlusion and full mouth rehabilitations, managing restorative complications of orthodontics and implants, ethical marketing and legal issues in cosmetic dentistry, biologically based approaches to tooth surface loss, clinical problem solving and smarter decision- making, bleaching, bonding, and various innovative minimally-destructive aesthetic techniques. He is the author, or co—author, of many peer-reviewed papers and multiple chapters in text books on various topics, as well as some mildly controversial opinion articles, most of which are free to download from www.martinkelleher.co.uk.



Hiten Halai

Grafts, Gummy Smiles And Growth Factors: An Insight Into Contemporary Periodontics

Hiten completed his BDS and Doctorate of Clinical Periodontology at Queen Mary, University of London and is a GDC registered specialist in Periodontics.

During his training he won multiple awards including the British Society of Periodontology (BSP) Audit Award, BSP Clinical Fellowship Award, Queen Mary Postgraduate Research Award and has been recognised for his contribution to clinical periodontology through a certificate of commendation through the Alpha Omega Dental Society (UK) in 2018. He also has presented his clinical and doctorate research work nationally and internationally and has articles published in peer-reviewed journals.

He has been involved in dental education and mentorship since 2014 and has supervised undergraduate students, dental foundation trainees and postgraduates in Periodontology as a clinical supervisor at King's College, London and Queen Mary, University of London.

He now spends his time running a postgraduate periodontal training academy called EduDent and also accepting periodontology referrals mainly at specialist referrals centres in Harley Street and Windsor.
