



Speakers



Zoë Brookes (BSc (Hons), BDS, MJDF (RCS Eng), PCHE, SFHEA, PhD)

Zoe is an Associate Professor of Dental Education and Research and Associate Head of School for Teaching and Learning at Peninsula Dental School (PDS), University of Plymouth, leading on curriculum delivery and assessment. PDS was ranked number 1 in the Guardian League tables in 2024 and 2025 under her leadership. She is also as a General Dentist at Peninsula Dental Social Enterprise delivering community-based dental care, with PDS receiving the Times Education Award for outstanding contribution to the community in 2023. She leads the Oral Microbiome Research Group at the University of Plymouth, which publishes on the links between oral microbes and systemic health. She set up one of the one of the first primary care teams, involving the Chief Dental Office, measuring blood pressure at the dentist. She led the FDI international task team for the the use of mouthwashes in oral care, and her publications include over 50 manuscripts and over 100 abstracts, with her mouthwash articles frequently ranking as the most cited. Zoë was recently elected Treasurer for the British Society of Dental Research, and Chair of Admissions for Dental Schools Council.



Professor Iain L. C. Chapple BDS, FDSRCPS (Glas), FDSRCS (Edin) Ph.D. CCST (Rest Dent)

Iain Chapple is former Director of Research, Institute of Clinical Sciences (2016-2022), Dean of the Dental School (2016-2020) at Birmingham University UK. He has published 15-textbooks, 44-chapters and >310 papers. Iain was awarded: The Royal College of Surgeons Tomes medal (2011); International Association Dental Research Distinguished Scientist (2018); European Federation of Periodontology Eminence Award (2022) and MBE in the 2022 Queens New Year's Honour's. He leads a regional periodontal service (referral base 6 million) and a national oral care service for adults with Epidermolysis Bullosa. He has a strong interest in mechanisms underpinning periodontal-systemic disease links and in immune-microbial interaction.



Speakers



Professor Nikos Donos DDS, MS, FHEA, FDS RCSEng, FDS RCSEd (ad hom), PhD

Nikos Donos is the Director of Research, Professor & Chair of Periodontology and Implant Dentistry, at the Centre for Oral Clinical Research (COCR), Institute of Dentistry, Queen Mary University of London (QMUL).

In 2024, Prof. Donos was awarded the prestigious International Association for Dental Research (IADR) Distinguished Scientist in Periodontal Disease Award and the European Federation of Periodontology (EFP) Distinguished Scientist Award. In 2011, he was presented with the IADR- Periodontology Group award in Periodontal Regenerative Medicine and in 2019 the American Academy of Periodontology (AAP) Clinical Research Award for his contribution as co-author. In 2004, Professor Donos was awarded the European Association of Osseointegration (EAO)- Basic Science Research Award.

In 2009, Prof. Donos has been presented with the title of Honorary Professor at the Faculty of Dentistry in Hong Kong, in 2012 the title of Adjunct Professor at the Dental School-Griffith University in Australia, in 2015 the title of Honorary Professor at UCL-Eastman Dental Institute and in 2019 the title of Honorary Professor, School of Dentistry, University of Queensland, Australia.

Prof. Donos has published more than 275 peer reviewed publications, is the editor of 5 textbooks and author/co-author of 15 book chapters in the field of Periodontology and Implant Dentistry.

Prof Donos has significant clinical experience in providing advanced treatment modalities to patients suffering from severe periodontal disease, peri-implantitis and in relation to implant dentistry.



Ashraf F. Fouad, DDS, MS

Dr. Fouad obtained his DDS, Certificate of Endodontics and MS at the University of Iowa.

He served on the faculty and in various administrative roles at University of Connecticut, the University of Maryland, and the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. He is currently Professor and Chair, Department of Endodontics, Director, Advanced Endodontics Program, and Interim Director, Health Information and Business Systems (HIBS) at the University of Alabama at Birmingham.

Dr. Fouad has published over 115 peer-reviewed manuscripts, 62 editorials and invited manuscripts, 25 textbook chapters and over 150 abstracts. He edited and co-authored several editions of the textbooks: Endodontic Microbiology, and Endodontics: Principles and Practice. He served as Associate editor of the Journal of Endodontics, and is currently Associate editor of Dental Traumatology and the Endodontics Section of Frontiers of Dental Medicine. He is a Diplomate and Past President of the American Board of Endodontics. He received the Distinguished Scientist Award from the Pulp Biology and Regeneration Group of the International Association of Dental Research in 2017, the AAE President's Award in 2022, and the International Grossman's Award in 2023.
